Residential Options and Fees

1. Full Boarding

- Students live on campus for the entire program duration, returning home only during academic breaks or vacations.
- o Fee: GHS 2,580 (for the program duration).
- o **Meals:** It is compulsory for boarders to pay the feeding fee, ensuring meals are provided throughout their stay in the boarding house.

2. Weekday Boarding

- Students stay on campus during the weekdays (Monday to Friday) and return home to their families over the weekend.
- Fee: GHS 2,580 (for the program duration).
- Meals: Weekday boarders must pay the feeding fee for meals provided from Monday to Friday.

3. Hostel Accommodation

- Students live on campus for the entire program duration and return home during academic breaks or vacations.
- Fee: GHS 3,000 (for the program duration).
- o **Meals:** Hostellers have the flexibility to purchase meals from the cafeteria as needed or opt for a feeding plan payable monthly in advance.

Meals/Feeding Fees

Monthly feeding plans are available for boarders and hostellers:

- **Standard Plan:** GHS 30.00 (two meals per day).
- **Standard Plus Plan:** GHS 40.00 (two meals per day).
- Cafeteria Options: Meals purchased on demand start at GHS 20.00 per plate.

PROSPECTUS FOR BOARDERS AND HOSTELLERS (PROVISIONAL)

Boarders and Hostellers of Supreme International College are required to report with the following items:

- 1. Student Mattress Standard size and durable for comfortable sleeping.
- 2. Bedspreads At least two bedspreads (one must be plain white).
- 3. Cutlery Set Including a knife, fork, and spoon.
- 4. Cups/Mugs, Flat Plate, and Hollow Bowl All items must be plain white.
- 5. Buckets Two plain white buckets for washing and bathing purposes.

6. Bags:

- Ecolac Bag or Similar Bags (trunks and chop boxes are not allowed).
- School Bag for carrying books and supplies to classes.

7. Decent Dresses and Footwear:

- Suitable outfits for classes.
- A church dress for Sunday worship.
- Sportswear for sporting activities and periodic health walks.

8. Personal Items:

- Provisions and toiletries (must be stored in a small jute bag under lock and key or a similar secure bag).
- 9. Cleaning Items Students may bring cleaning supplies or pay a fee of GHC125 to cover these items.
